### Rationale

The WASA Gala at Luna Cinemas in Leederville showcases the students' work every year. This year's theme is 'RUP-TURE'

### **Target Audience**

The target audience of the gala includes WA Screen Academy students and staff, family and friends of those students, aspiring filmmakers, the film industry across Australia, students and staff from Australian Universities, and the general public interested in film.

### Importance

The design of the gala poster is important to appeal to younger audiences, influencing high-school and undergraduate university students to pursuit and join the WA Screen Academy. It is also important to pay homage to the students who have worked on the productions being screened at the gala.

### **Brand Identity**

WASA is an output for creativity, allowing students to express their own stories and truth in their work, as well inspiring their audiences. WASA also allows students to prepare or 'break out' into the film industry.

### Choice of design

My interpretation of 'Rupture' is the process of breaking apart. I have chosen a subtle approach of referencing film (through the incorporation of grain and a light leak effect) to create intrigue, and allow audiences to find out more information on their own.

### Typograph

My design includes stretched out letters and duplication of text to express the process of breaking. The text is placed in front of a gradient background, with an overlay layer, creating an 'overexposed' and 'light leak' effect which is seen in 35mm film. I have duplicated the text three times to portray the text 'rupturing.' I also made the text slightly blurry but readable, imitating a photo with a high shutterspeed. In addition, I have chosen a simplistic font, Urbane, for readability purposes, as well as a level of sophistication due to the Gala being a prestigious event.

### Background

The gradient background of orange and purple, are the colours I associate with the word Rupture. I also chose the colour orange as that is the usual colour of light leaks along with white, which is the colour of the text.

I made sure that each colour of the background can be seen through the text, to create texture. The background is not in the same position in all of the mediums, as I wanted the waves of colour to flow across the page, which is different in a landscape and portrait position.

There is also grain in the background to add another layer of texture, and to create a filmic style.

### Method of Approach

The designs will predominantly be digital, to reduce waste. If physical, must be recycable.

Physical advertisement posters will be placed throughout the City of Vincent, City of Stirling, Perth CBD, and WA universities including ECU.

Digital advertisements will be posted on social media apps/websites including but not limited to, Facebook, Instagram and Eventbrite.

### Mediums

The physical and digital advertisements include:

- social media banner and profile
- physical and digital posters & flyers
- physical and digital booklet

### **Future Ventures**

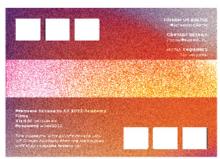

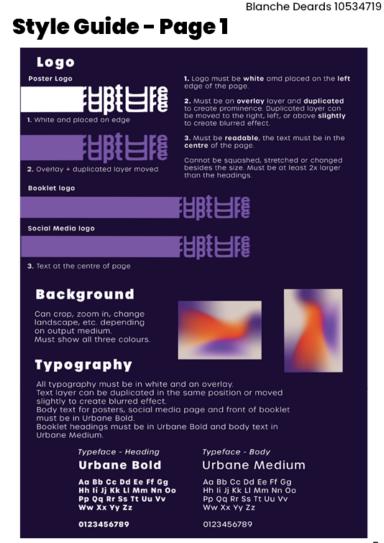
